TRICK



6 levels of standard trick titles. 5 levels of Masters. Certificates, ribbons and rosettes.

CANINE CONDITIONING



Practice strength, flexibility, balance and coordination. Levels 1-4 + Champion.

STUNT DOG



Continuous routine of set tricks. Live or unedited video.
7 levels.

ANIMAL ACTORS



Get listed on Animal Actors database. 5 levels.

SPECIALITY



Several fun titles to suit all ages and capabilities. New titles released periodically.

Apart from the fun Speciality titles, the levels in each type of title need to be submitted consecutively. There's no option to skip a level. If your dog passes the same level in Trick + Canine Conditioning + Stunt dog, they will become a Triple Crown holder. You can purchase a pdf certificate to be emailed to you for printing or go for it to be printed professionally and posted to you (worldwide). Ribbons, rosettes are also available as extras.

Your dog becomes a Triple Crown holder automatically when he/she achieves the same level in the following: Trick Dog, Canine Conditioning Fitness and Stunt Dog. For example Triple Crown 1 for completing Novice Trick dog + Canine Conditioning Level 1 + Novice Stunt Dog. No need to get additional approval from your instructor, you can go ahead and purchase the Triple Crown certificate and stash.

You don't need to submit your for your certificates individually, can do them all at once or in batches. However you can't jump levels: have to purchase Novice - Advance before or together with your Expert order. I can evaluate Novice - Expert free of charge and happy to give advice on Champion and Grand Champion applications, but you'll need to submit those to DMWYD staff for official assessment.

Prerequisite:

Each Masters title **must be earned consecutively** (can't jump a level), and each Masters title may be earned only **after earning the corresponding standard trick title**. So for Advanced Masters, you need to have passed Advanced Trick Dog as well as Intermediate Masters.

Masters Champion is launching in May 2023.

Levels 1-4 don't need to be perfectly done to qualify for a title: I need to see that you understand the optimal form and you are striving to achieve that with your dog. If a particular exercise is not suitable for your dog because of health or age, let me know and we can find an alternative. As with trick titles, Canine Conditioning titles have to be submitted consecutively, you can't skip levels.

Awarded to animals who have proven themselves by performing up to expectations on a professional set.

As with trick titles, Animal Actor titles have to be submitted consecutively, you can't skip levels. Credentialed animals are added to the online registry which includes their photo and the owner's contact details, allowing productions and animal acting agencies to find and hire the animals. This is most useful in the US, but skills learned and demonstrated through the programme will be invaluable for all budding talents across the world.



Stunt Dog is a live performance. It may be done in person (e.g. on zoom), or by unedited pre-recorded video. As with all the trick and canine conditioning title series, you can't skip levels, they need to be done consequtively.

Beat the Clock (BTC...)

12 tricks in 24, or 48, or 60 seconds. Certificate will state the duration. You choose which tricks, no strict criteria on level.



Alphabet Challenge (AtoZ)

26 tricks starting with each letter of the alphabet, in any language. You decide on which tricks to use.



That's My Name! (AKA)



25 tricks using the letters of your animal's name. You decide which tricks to use.



Summer of Ruff (SOR)

Perform 15 of the 20 challenges.

Easter Bunny Run

Walk or run 3 km with your dog. Can be done in multiple sessions if needed because of dog's or handler's health / age. Evidence submitted can be a fitness tracker, a video, etc.



2K-9 Ruff Run (2K9)

Run or brisk walk 2 km (1.24 miles) with your dog. Can be done in multiple sessions. Evidence submitted can be a fitness tracker, a video, etc.



Triple Threat (T3)

3 kilometers (1.86 miles) run/walk + 3 reps high energy burst (e.g jumps) + 3 minutes stretch. Only need proof of run / walk.
